- String or Yarn: ~20in
- Stapler or Glue
- **Hole Puncher**
- Markers to decorate!

Step 1:

Decorate your toilet paper rolls anyway you like! You can use paint, colored pencils, markers, or stickers!

Step 2:

Hold the rolls side by side and staple them at each end so they stay together. Craft glue will also work!




Step 3:

Gather your string, yarn, or ribbon. Attach each end of the string to the top of the rolls using glue, a stapler, or by punching holes and tying knots.

Step 4:

Take your new DIY binoculars outside to vour backvard or local park and complete your next activity, the **Bird Scavenger Hunt!**
